# Packing Patch Reef with Pickleball

District Commissioners continue to expand pickleball opportunities within the Boca Raton community, providing more ways to enjoy America's fastest growing sport.

The initial weeks of the new year include the opening of new courts, progress toward a covered pickleball center, and a District-owed park hosting one of Florida's biggest professional pickleball tournaments.

Earlier this week the District completed the conversion of two additional Patch Reef Park tennis courts into six new pickleball courts, doubling the park's lighted public courts.

The opening of those courts coincided with Patch Reef becoming the center of the pickleball world – at least for a week.

# Arctic Blast At Sugar Sand

Winter in Florida, normally fairly tame, will get a little wilder when the Under the Arctic: Digging in Permafrost exhibit opens at Sugar Sand Park's Science Explorium.

The interactive exhibit, which opens on January 27, will give an arctic feel to one of Boca Raton's hottest parks.

Arctic permafrost exhibits and videos teach visitors about the earth's past, present, and future - while hinting at solutions to current problems.

Permafrost covers nearly a quarter of the northern hemisphere's land mass.


